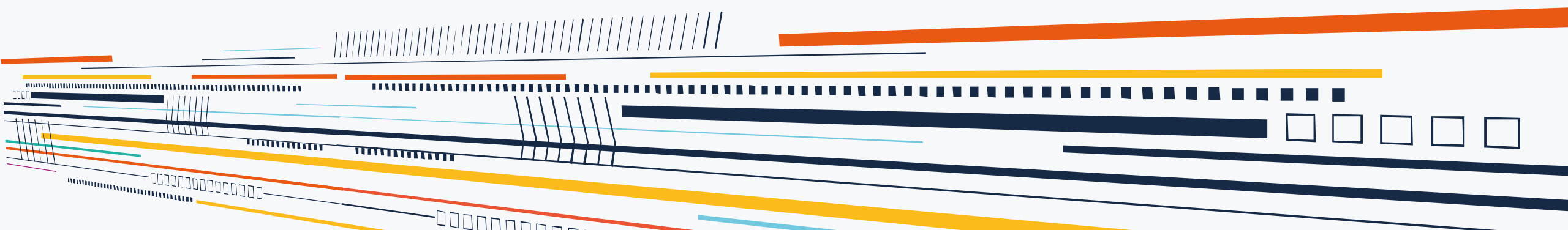

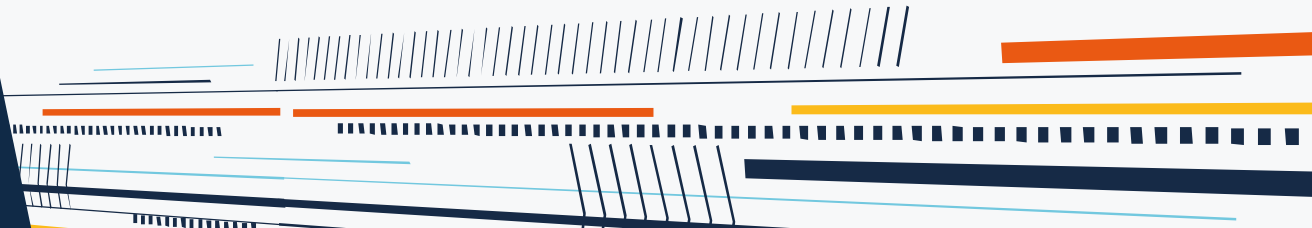

See when named users last logged in

Oliver Woodall asks..

“ I recently hit my 50 named user licence limit. “Well buy some more then!” I hear you cry, however, most of these users will not be back, having logged on for training but with the main responsibility of configuring Squared Up falling on one or two key people in their respective teams.

It'd be useful to know who is 'best' to remove (and thus free up a licence for someone else), based on last login. Is this exposed in a log file anywhere?

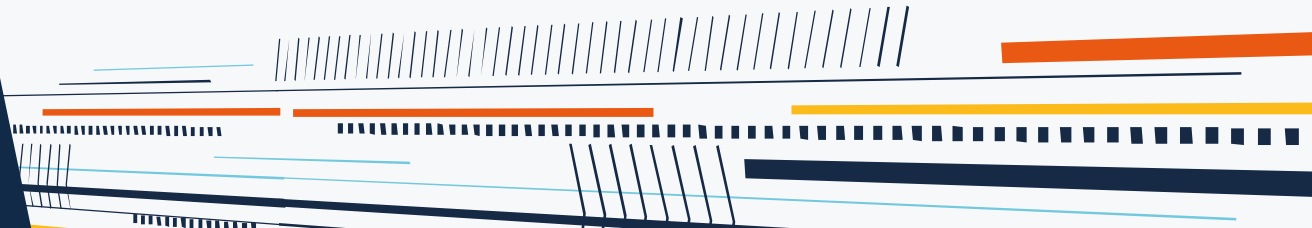
